
Dear Mr. Galassie:

Please accept our endorsement of The Admiral at the Lake's ("The Admiral") CON application to open its long-term skilled nursing beds to the general public.

Northwestern Memorial Hospital ("NMH"), located at 251 E. Huron in Chicago, Illinois, intends to utilize The Admiral, a long-term care facility, which is applying for a Certificate of Need permit application to open its 36 skilled-nursing beds to the general public.

NMH typically discharges approximately 160 patients per month to area skilled nursing facilities. While referrals are difficult to project, since they are based on a patient's choice, services available, and payor arrangements, given The Admiral's proximity to NMH, we believe it will serve as a good option for many of our patients requiring skilled nursing services.
