This document is submitted in compliance with the Health Facilities Planning Act (20 ILCS 3960) and those administrative rules promulgated to implement the Act, specifically 77 Illinois Administrative Code 1130.720, 1130.760 and 1130.770. It serves as our Notice of Obligation, the Annual Progress Report and the Project Completion Notice.

On September 12, 2012 the Health Facilities and Services Review Board approved the application for permit for the above project.

The scope of the project is the discontinuation of the 76 bed facility for persons with mental illness known as the H. Douglas Singer Mental Health Center located at 4402 North Main Street, Rockford, Illinois 61103.

On September 27th, 28th and on October 1st various parties were notified as required by state law (20 ILCS 1705/8) of the closure of admissions on October 1st, and the realignment of the geographic area to relate to two other state operated facilities. The admissions were closed on October 1, 2012.

The project has no cost and therefore requires no financial resources.

The project's cost, scope and number of beds to be discontinued are in accord with the Permit issued by the Health Facilities and Services Review Board for this project
