**Re: Response for Impact Statement/Discontinuation of Maryville Behavioral Health Hospital**

Dear Mr. Roberts:

Our ten bed adolescent acute psychiatric unit is a highly specialized and ONLY admits/accepts DCFS Wards of the State in transfer from other hospitals and/or emergency rooms (rarely). All of our admissions are referred to us by the DCFS Gatekeeper and only after it was determined that they met specific criteria. Consequently, few if any, of Maryville's children meet the severity and chronicity criteria necessary for admission to our unit. Finally, due to the smaller size of our unit, extended length of stay secondary to DCFS placement issues, and capacity for one or two new DCFS admissions per week, we respond no to the ability to "accommodate a portion or all of your patients". As a result of the size and uniqueness of our unit The University of Illinois Hospital & Health Sciences System will not be adversely affected by the closure of the Maryville unit.


Dear Mr. Roberts:


Dear Dr. Novak,
