Project #14-039, Notice of Project Conclusion

Dear Ms. Avery and Ms. Senger:

This letter serves as a notice that the above-referenced project has been brought to a conclusion, as required by 77 Ill. Adm. Code 1130.770(b).

This project was granted a CON permit on November 12, 2014, for the discontinuation of Centegra Specialty Hospital - Woodstock, South Street, as a licensed general hospital. The project was approved with no cost (\$0).

At the time when Project #14-039 was approved, Centegra Specialty Hospital – Woodstock, South Street, offered 2 categories of service: General Long Term Care (LTC) and Acute Mental Illness (AMI).

The Illinois Health Facilities and Services Review Board (IHFSRB) granted a CON permit to discontinue the LTC Category of Service (Project #14-038) on November 12, 2014. On September 23, 2014, Centegra Specialty Hospital – Woodstock, South Street temporarily suspended the LTC Category of Service, as explained in a letter dated October 1, 2014. As noted in that letter, the last patient was discharged from the LTC Unit on September 22, 2014. An update to that letter, dated October 30, 2014, was also submitted. Project #14-038 was completed when the CON permit was approved on November 12, 2014, and the Notice that the project had been brought to completion was submitted on November 25, 2014.

The Illinois Health Facilities and Services Review Board (IHFSRB) granted a CON permit to discontinue the AMI Category of Service (Project #14-003) on April 22, 2014. The last patient was discharged from the hospital's AMI Unit on June 18, 2015, as a result of which this project was completed. Notice that the project has been brought to completion is being submitted simultaneously with the notice that this project has been completed.

Now that both of the categories of service that were offered at Centegra Specialty Hospital – Woodstock, South Street have been discontinued, this hospital has ceased to operate as a licensed general acute care hospital.

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Since there are no project costs, this letter meets the requirements for notice of project completion.
