It is my belief that this is not a needed service in our community. This would jeopardize viability of our existing dialysis services offered by Danville Dialysis Service. Dr. Sodhi and his staff have been providing quality nephrology care and services to our community for 38 years. He opened his outpatient clinic in 2002 and has met, and continues to meet the complex needs of the renal patients in our community and the surrounding area. This facility has the capacity to accommodate more patients. It is my thought that we should utilize this clinic to its capacity first before granting any application for duplication of services.

To summarize, I respectfully request that you deny the Certificate of Need application, as I strongly believe Danville Dialysis does an excellent job of meeting the needs of the patient's and their families in our community.
