Speaking on behalf of The Rockford Surgical Service, please allow me to voice our enthusiastic support for the St. Anthony Medical Center Modernization Project listed above. Our practice has provided the highest quality surgical care to the Rockford and Northern Illinois region for over sixty years, and we have been blessed to have OSF St. Anthony as a partner in our goals of growth, innovation and compassion from the start. 
