
On June 26, 2013, the Illinois Health Facilities and Services Review Board (State Board) approved your request for a change of ownership exemption. The approval was based upon the application's compliance with applicable provisions of 77 IAC 1130.520.

- **Exemption Number: 007-13**
- **Description of Project:** The exemption holders have been approved for a change of ownership of Rush Oak Park Hospital, 520 South Maple, Oak Park, Illinois.
- **Exemption Holders:** Rush University Medical Center, 1700 West Van Buren, Chicago, Illinois, Rush Oak Park Hospital
- **Licensee/Operating Entity:** Rush Oak Park Hospital
- **Owner of Site:** Rush Oak Park Hospital
- **Exemption Amount:** \$21,078,000
- **Name of the Exemption: Rush Oak Park Hospital**
- **Address where the Project will be located:** at 520 South Maple, Oak Park, Illinois
- **Project Completion Date:** July 1, 2013

You are reminded that this exemption is only valid for 24 months from the date of approval and is not transferable or assignable. This exemption must be completed within the 24-month period. To demonstrate completion of this transaction, the exemption holder must provide the State Board with the date that the ownership change occurred and also provide a copy of the license or certification issued pursuant to the change of ownership. Failure to provide the required notification shall subject the exemption holder to the sanctions provided under Section 14 of the Illinois Health Facilities Planning Act. The exemption holder is also reminded that 77 IAC 1130.140 defines transactions that constitute a change of ownership of a health care facility. Please review the definitions referenced.

The State Board's approval does not exempt the transaction from any other regulatory, certification or licensure requirements that may be applicable prior to acquisition. The exemption will be invalid should the facility for which the change of ownership was granted cease to be an existing health care facility as defined in 77 IAC 1130.140.
