ILHIE Advisory Committee and OHIT Update

Krysta Heaney reported that ILHIE Authority Board has a new executive director, Raul Recarey.

The Illinois Health Information Exchange (ILHIE) Authority Board met on September 19th and approved the ILHIE Data, Privacy, and Security Committee report and recommendations on the privacy and security consent management policy. They are ready to move forward with proposed statutory language to the mental health act during veto session.

Mark Chudzinski reported that the ILHIE Authority Board adopted a policy that all data and all patients that participate in the HIE have the ability to opt out of further disclosure for the HIE. In terms of exercising that opt out right, the provider is required to provide sufficient information to the patient for it to be meaningful disclosure. The provider has to advise the patient that an HIE is going to be used and that the patient has the right to opt out of further disclosure to the HIE. This language is in the proposed changes to the mental health act.

Mark noted that there are operational challenges and details to figure out still and welcomes all suggestions.
