Simplifies Care Management

In a time of care teams, medical homes and consumer travel, patients often see many providers. EHR Connect is a low cost, secure way to fill communication gaps in the continuum of care by providing immediate access to patient medical records from all their providers. You now have more complete data from which to make treatment decisions. Your patient's records are also available to other providers through EHR Connect, keeping all members of the care team connected. With EHR Connect, there is no more time spent responding to requests, or requesting medical records.

A Secure, Aggregated, Request and Retrieval Service

EHR Connect allows providers to request and receive encrypted, up-to-date patient medical information. The health records are aggregated from multiple provider sources including primary care, hospitals, specialists and others. Records can include patient diagnosis, medications, allergies, lab and image reports, discharge summaries and more.

Health Information Exchange (HIE) Enables:

- Having patient information available whenever needed
- Having more complete information available at point of care
- Improved care coordination
- Improved work efficiencies
- Improved patient communications, conveniences and increased safety
- Fewer duplicate tests and procedures
- Satisfying meaningful use objectives

1. Your Patient Makes an Appointment

Before they arrive, review their up-to-date, consolidated medical record. Perhaps they have seen other providers, been prescribed new medications or been hospitalized. Find out by signing into your EHR and requesting their records through EHR Connect. Keep up-to-date on your patient's health care activities.

2. You Receive a Referral or a Transition of Care Document

Before your new patient arrives, review their up-to-date, consolidated medical record for any diagnosis, medications, allergies etc. Have more complete information available at point of care.

3. Your Patient Arrives Unconscious in the Emergency Department

In a crisis, with limited identity information, emergency department providers can request and retrieve life saving patient information such as medications, allergies and diagnoses with EHR Connect.

Having your patient's records before they arrive means less dependence on a patient's memory and spending more quality time with them. It also means fewer duplicate forms for you and your patients to fill out.
