Patricia King opened the meeting at 11:30 AM, hosted by OHIT at the State of Illinois J.R. Thompson Center in Downtown Chicago and a telephone conference call-in number. It was noted that notice of the meeting and the agenda were posted on the OHIT website and at the Chicago meeting location no later than 48 hours prior to the meeting. Roll was taken, and the ability of those attending by telephone to hear and participate was confirmed.

Ms. King asked if there were any revisions needed to the previous meeting's minutes. Ms. King noted that the date on the last set of minutes was incorrect. Hearing no other corrections, she asked for a motion to approve the minutes. A motion was given, it was seconded, and it was approved.

Ms. King went through an update of the work on the analysis of the statutes. The analysis of the Managed Care and Reform Act, Medical Practice Act, Consent by Minors Act have not been completed. The Consent by Minors Act will be completed soon. One of the members felt that consent by a minor for treatment would constitute consent for the HIE.

The analysis for the Hospital Licensing Act, Nursing Home Care Act, Personal Information Protection Act, Illinois Adverse Reporting Act, Common Law Agency, Common Law Privacy have been finished. Ms. King stated that she will compile the summaries.

Ms. King said that the analysis for the Manage Care Reform Act will be completed by the next call. She will also check into the status of the Medical Practice Act.

The group decided to look at the HIE laws in Minnesota and New Mexico and discuss them in the next meeting.

One member asked if there was a group looking at reproductive health information and the HIE. The member wondered if there is/should be a provision on sharing reproductive health information, such as pregnancy, birth, adoption, and abortions.

The group set the next meeting time at June 29, 2011 at 11AM.
