1) Status of the Supplemental Appropriation

- **Update on Attestation for Program Year 2013**

Mike Casey updated the group saying that the appropriation had not been approved by the legislature yet and he doesn't anticipate anything happening until the end of legislative session at the end of May.

2) EHR/PIP Status Update

- **Payments to date (5/10/13)**

2,864 Eligible Providers (EPs) - \$60,144,617 (2,145 from 2011, 719 from 2012, all Year 1 Payments)

128 Eligible Hospital (EHs) - \$161,014,668 (92 from 2011; 2012-36 Year 1 Payments, 43 Year 2 Payments)

Total - \$221,159,285

Dave Barnes reported that there have been no changes for payments to date due to no funds available.

3) Pre-payment Audit Process

- **Attestations in work queue (5/10/13):**

EPs – 1,609 (1,010 for AIU Year 1 Payments; 599 for MU Year 2 Payments)

EHS – 43 (all 2012, 20 Year 1 Payments, 23 Year 2 Payments)

Dave Barnes reported that the attestation period ended on April 30th. Final numbers for 2012 EP attestations are listed. For the year, HFS received 2,328 attestations and are in the queue for approval.

4) Outreach to EPs

Jeff Todd updated the group saying that the contract is with the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services waiting for approval. They will approve it at the same time as the amended IAPD submitted from HFS. The Regional Extension Centers are working on strategies based on the information provided from HFS to make sure that providers are well positioned to attest to Adopt, Implement, Upgrade and Meaningful Use.
