Resolution Approving Agency Data Rules  
of the Illinois Health Information Exchange Authority

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ILLINOIS HEALTH INFORMATION EXCHANGE  
AUTHORITY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Authority. This resolution is adopted pursuant to Section 15(e) of the Illinois Health Information Exchange and Technology Act, 20 Illinois Compiled Statutes 3860/1 et seq. (the "Act").

Section 2. Approval of Agency Data Rules.

WHEREAS, pursuant the intergovernmental agreement between the Office of Health Information Technology and the Department of Health and Family Services regarding certain data that will be utilized for the development and implementation of the Illinois Health Information Exchange, the Illinois Health Information Exchange Authority is required to adopt certain regulations under the Illinois Public Aid Code (Ill. Rev. Stat. 1981, Ch 23, pars. 11-9 through 11-12) to protect public aid recipient and applicant information from prohibited disclosure;

WHEREAS, the Illinois Administrative Procedure Act sets forth a formal process pursuant to which agencies can engage in rule making;

WHEREAS, the Board has reviewed the proposed Agency Data Rules and wishes to formally adopt them in accordance with the procedures of the Illinois Administrative Procedure Act;

RESOLVED, that the Agency Data Rules in the form presented to the Board are hereby approved, and that the Acting Executive Director is hereby authorized and directed to initiate the formal rule making process for their adoption, with such modifications to the Agency Data Rules as the Acting Executive Director in her discretion may deem necessary or desirable.

Section 3. Enactment. This resolution shall take effect immediately. If any section, paragraph or provision of this resolution shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this resolution.
