General Duties: An Actuary I employee performs responsible and technical research work in the actuarial analysis of insurance companies or of various public employees' pension funds in the State and also determines compliance with state laws and regulations;

The requirements for a minimal passing grade are as follows:

Training and Experience: Requires knowledge, skill and mental development equivalent to completion of four years of college, with courses in higher mathematics, such as calculus, probability and statistics. Requires two years professional actuarial experience with life insurance companies or in analysis of life insurance company operations. Preferably requires the equivalent to the certificate received for completion of Parts 1 and 2 and any one of Parts 3, 4 or 5 of the examinations given by the Society of Actuaries.

Tests and weights: Training and experience 100%.

Length of eligibility period: One year.
