Monthly Salary Range: \$6141 - \$9472

General Duties: Subject to administrative approval, employees perform highly responsible professional actuarial work by providing counsel and advice and conducting technical research in the insurance field of life, accident, health, casualty, property, etc. Employees conduct technical actuarial determinations of insurance firms doing business in the State and develop and prepare reports and recommend appropriate actions to the chief actuary or to the department director and administrators. The position may involve supervision of lower level actuaries.

The requirements for a minimal passing grade are as follows:

Training and Experience: Requires education and experience equivalent to four years of college with courses in higher mathematics, such as calculus, probability and statistics and four years professional actuarial experience in the life, accident, health, casualty, and property insurance field. Preferably requires the equivalent to the certificate received for the completion of necessary examinations to qualify as an Associate or Fellow of the Society of Actuaries (A.S.A. or F.S.A.) or Casualty Actuarial Society (A.C.A.S. or F.C.A.S.) and the type and kind of experience and training necessary for membership in the American Academy of Actuaries.

Tests and weights: Training and experience 100%.

Length of eligibility period: One year.
