General Duties: Under general direction, a Juvenile Justice Youth & Family Specialist Supervisor supervises assigned staff on a treatment team and provides leadership and direction to the other professional care specialists on the unit, assigns cases to staff juvenile justice counselors, monitors the quality and timeliness of their work, provides direction and guidance in the establishment of treatment goals and methods, acts as a resource in the provision of professional services and case supervision. The employee may additionally assume a complex caseload of special needs youth.

The requirements for a minimum passing grade are as follows:

Training and Experience: Completion of a Master's degree in counseling or a closely related social sciences degree plus three years of professional experience working with youth in juvenile services. Candidates must be over the age of 21. A characteristic of this work is the need to schedule evening and weekend work activity in order to provide youth services outside school hours.

Tests and weights: Training and experience 100%.

Length of eligibility period: One year.

Option SS - Spanish Speaking: At the time of the job interview, the eligible will be required to exhibit the ability to understand and speak Spanish and English fluently. Failure to exhibit this ability will result in disqualification for this option.

Counties in which positions are established: Champaign, Cook, DuPage, Henry, Jersey, Kane (SS), Peoria, St Clair, Saline (SS), Sangamon, Winnebago.

(SS) Indicates Spanish Speaking Option is also established in that county.
