PSYCHOLOGIST I - 35611

No Option – Regular Test

Option MC – Manual Communication

All selected options may be listed on one application.

General duties: A Psychologist I, under direct supervision, performs professional psychologist duties; conducts initial assessments of recipients in an intake or admissions setting and makes the preliminary decision on whether to accept a recipient into the system or to deflect the recipient to another agency or group; coordinates programs for caseload recipients; assures the treatment/habilitation plan for each recipient is accurate, the plan is updated as recipient's needs change, and monitors the treatment/care given to ensure compliance with the treatment/habilitation plan; modifies established treatment/habilitation plans to conform to recipient's needs and appropriate and accepted treatment practices; conducts psychological interviews with persons requesting mental health services; participates in or conducts psychological testing and assessments; consults with senior Psychologists regarding the interpretation of test scores and results of interviews; serves as a member of the interdisciplinary team and assists in the design of clinical plans that meet recipients' needs; conducts individual and/or group therapy as needed.

Minimum Training and Experience Required to Obtain Supplemental Questionnaire:

Possession of a Master's degree in psychology, plus two years of professional experience in psychology or satisfactory completion of Psychology Associate Program

NOTE: Experience cannot be accepted in lieu of the Master's degree in psychology. A graduate degree in a field other than psychology is acceptable only if the candidate is currently licensed in Illinois as a Psychologist.

Tests and weights: Training and experience evaluation (Supplemental Questionnaire) 100%. Candidates must meet minimum training and experience requirements; however the grade will be derived from the questionnaire.

Length of eligibility period: One year.

The minimum requirements and scoring standards are different for each title, but the information required on the questionnaire is the same for all of these titles.

Option MC - Manual Communication Skills: At the time of the job interview, the eligible will be required to exhibit the ability to communicate effectively with the deaf by utilizing American Sign Language concepts and manual communication skills. Failure to exhibit these abilities will result in disqualification for this option.
