DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF WORK:

Under direct supervision, performs skilled tasks at a skilled level in the construction, maintenance or repair of buildings and other masonry structures; may instruct or supervise a group of helpers or inmates engaged in performing or assisting with similar operations.

ILLUSTRATIVE EXAMPLES OF WORK:

1. Performs general masonry work in the repair, maintenance, construction or alteration of baking ovens, boilers, incinerators, window and door openings, walls, sidewalks, floors, sewers, catch basins, piers, curbs, chimneys and other masonry structures, usually using brick, but occasionally using plaster, concrete, tile, cement block, mortar, mastic and similar structural materials.
2. Mixes mortar or concrete by hand or with portable mixer.
3. Supervises helpers or inmates in performing related trade tasks.
4. Performs other duties as required or assigned which are reasonably within the scope of the enumerated duties above.

DESIRABLE REQUIREMENTS:

Education and Experience

Requires knowledge, skill and mental development equivalent to completion of eight years elementary school.

Knowledges, Skills and Abilities

Requires working knowledge of the tools, materials, methods and standard practices of the trade.

Requires ability to instruct and direct unskilled workers.

Requires skill in the use of tools of the trade.

Requires ability to perform all tasks usually associated with brickmasons.

Requires ability to read, interpret and work from plans, simple drawings or sketches.
