PLASTERER

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF WORK:

Under direct supervision, performs plastering work at the journeyman level in the construction, maintenance, repair and alteration of state property; may supervise unskilled workers or inmates in institutions.

ILLUSTRATIVE EXAMPLES OF WORK:

1. Prepares surfaces for plastering.
2. Replaces broken metal or wooden lath; chips out broken plaster, concrete or tile.
3. Mixes plaster according to standard proportions.
4. Applies required number of coats of plaster, using standard or special tools; finishes off surface.
5. May direct work of unskilled workers.
6. May apply asbestos insulation to steam and water pipes; may repair or replace tile on floors and walls.
7. Performs other duties as required or assigned which are reasonably within the scope of the duties enumerated above.

DESIRABLE REQUIREMENTS:

Education and Experience

Requires no formal education.

Requires experience necessary to qualify as a journeyman plasterer.

Knowledges, Skills and Abilities

Requires working knowledge of the tools, materials, methods and standard practices of the trade.

Requires ability to direct unskilled workers.

Requires skill in the use of the tools and materials of the trade.

Requires ability to perform all tasks usually associated with journeymen plasterers.

Requires ability to interpret verbal or written work orders.
