DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF WORK:

Under immediate supervision, performs a variety of semiskilled tasks involving the erection and maintenance of traffic control signs on the state highway system; performs other duties as required or assigned.

ILLUSTRATIVE EXAMPLES OF WORK:

1. Erects traffic control signs on the state highway system, as directed.
2. Maintains traffic control signs on state highways through straightening, removing and replacing those in need of repair.
3. Periodically cleans and washes traffic control signs.
4. Unloads and handles treated 4" x 4" wooden posts or galvanized steel posts.
5. Drives Class "A" CDL vehicle (Tandem axle boom mounted truck) and 1 ½ ton stake body sign truck.
6. Operates motor driven portable posthole auger, air compressors and truck mounted portable steam cleaner.
7. Operates all mechanical tools and utilizes hand tools as necessary for the erection and maintenance of signs.
8. Performs other duties as required or assigned which are reasonably within the scope of the duties enumerated above.

DESIRABLE REQUIREMENTS:

Education and Experience

Requires knowledge, skill and mental development equivalent to completion of eight years elementary school.

Requires one-year experience in sign erecting work.

SIGN HANGER (continued)

Knowledges, Skills and Abilities

Requires working knowledge of the operating equipment used in this work, such as lightweight truck, portable motor driven posthole auger, air compressor and portable steam cleaner.

Requires ability to erect, maintain and clean traffic control signs on state highways, and to perform other arduous physical labors.

Requires skill and ability in operating power and hand tools.

Requires ability to drive a truck.

Requires ability to read pencil sketches.

Requires Class "A" CDL license with appropriate endorsements.
