SIGN PAINTER HELPER

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF WORK:

Under immediate supervision, performs routine tasks of unskilled and semiskilled nature in and around a sign shop assisting sign painters.

ILLUSTRATIVE EXAMPLES OF WORK:

1. Assists sign painters in painting backgrounds and embossing signs and dead-end boards.
2. Mixes paint; sharpens squeegees; cleans stencils and silk screens; stencils with silk screens.
3. Applies glass beaded material to highway signs.
4. Prepares spray gun, booth equipment and painting materials for use.
5. Sprays primer or enamels on highway signs or traffic signal equipment; operates baking oven to dry and harden paint.
6. Cleans all spraying equipment and spraying room.
7. Performs other duties as required or assigned which are reasonably within the scope of the duties enumerated above.

DESIRABLE REQUIREMENTS:

Education and Experience

Requires no formal education.

Requires one year experience or apprentice training in a trade school or sign painting shop.

Knowledges, Skills and Abilities

Requires elementary knowledge of the principles of sign painting and spraying and common practices, processes, materials and equipment of the trade.

Requires skill in routine use of the tools of the trade.

Requires ability to perform simple sign painting, spraying and other routine work.

Requires ability to carry out simple oral instructions.
