TEACHER OF BARBERING

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF WORK:

Under general supervision, teaches the barbering trade to inmates, patients or students in state institutions which have been approved as a school of barbering by the Department of Registration and Education.

ILLUSTRATIVE EXAMPLES OF WORK:

1. Forms barber classes; checks on prospective students to see that they meet requirements described in the Illinois Barbering Act.
2. Conducts classes in practical barbering and theory.
3. Maintains progress records on student barbers.
4. Arranges for students to take the state barber's examination.
5. Orders necessary equipment and supplies to operate a modern barbershop.
6. Cuts hair of inmates or patients.
7. Performs other duties as required or assigned which are reasonably within the scope of the enumerated duties above.

DESIRABLE REQUIREMENTS:

Education and Experience

Requires knowledge, skill and mental development equivalent to completion of four years high school.

Requires possession of a teaching certificate from the Illinois Department of Registration and Education and a valid Illinois license as a barber.

Knowledges, Skills and Abilities

Requires extensive knowledge of practices and methods in the care of hair and skin.

Requires extensive knowledge of modern barbering techniques, methods, practices and the operating maintenance and sterilization of barbering instruments.

Requires ability to instruct others in the methods and skills of barbering.

Requires skill in the use of tools and equipment of the barbering trade.

Requires ability to keep progress records on students.

Requires responsibility for safekeeping barbering tools.
