


## Illinois Torture Inquiry and Relief Commission

(An 8-member body composed of 1 volunteer Chairman and 7 volunteer Commissioners; two volunteer alternate Commissioners serve when a regular Commissioner is absent)



The Illinois Torture Inquiry and Relief Commission (TIRC) is an independent Commission established to “conduct inquiries into claims of torture.” *See* 775 ILCS 40/35(2), 775 ILCS 40/5. Its total operating budget for fiscal year 2014 is \$300,000. *See* Public Act 98-0027. TIRC has one office at 100 West Randolph Street, Ste. 5-100, Chicago, Illinois 60601.
